Appendix

1. Access to the bar area should be restricted to persons of the age of 18 years and over i.e. no children or young persons to be permitted within 1 meter of the bar. Appropriate signage must be clearly displayed within the bar area, relative to age restrictions and the relevant conditions of the licence. Signage should clearly identify: *No under 18's served alcohol *Persons who appear to be under the age of 25 will be asked to provide identification *The specific opening and closing times of the bar *Responsible drinking message *No smoking signs 3. There should be a personal licence holder present within the bar area at all times and all staff involved in the sale and/or supply of alcohol should have received the two hours mandatory training, as required under the legislation. 4. Plastic drinking containers should be used throughout the duration of the event. Children and Young Persons (0 – 17 years) may only gain entry to the event if accompanied by a responsible parent or guardian over the age of 25 years. Children and Young Persons (0 – 17 years) may remain until **0030 hours** but only if supervised by a responsible parent or guardian over the age of 25 years. All reasonable requests made by the police are complied with.
