Comment:For years we have been concerned about the hazard posed by the derelict kennels on the site, where young children often play (especially in summer), so removal of this dangerous structure is a positive step. The proposed dwelling and all the eco-friendly text and laudable ambitions during construction (hand digging, no heavy plant, hand demolition, reuse of stones etc) appear to be sensitive to the landscape. Is it possible to install "screw piles" without having heavy plant access the site through the existing woodland? Major concerns are: (1) lack of sunlight (trees in summer, elevation of sun in winter) will result in additional tree felling or substantial trimming being required; (2) parking of 2 vehicles and bins on the edge of the existing road immediately behind our property will affect our first floor outlook and will cause additional noise; (3) parking and access will be on a blind corner for those exiting the CP site or Peel House. There are some inconsistencies in the claims, for example in Section 3.3 the left-hand "artistic" photo clearly shows garden landscaping and section 3.4 refers to using rainwater for "irrigation" - of what, as no landscaping is proposed? The existing footpath used by dog walkers etc passes immediately next

to the site. Is the applicant happy with this?
