Crowbyres Yard - Second-hand Car Dealing - Application**

Dear Sirs, I refer to the above license application and ask you not to grant this for the following reasons :

The area is now more residential than before and to allow this type of business would devalue the status of the area and worth of properties. Residents would be less likely to spend as much on maintenance.

The 'working' noise would spoil our enjoyment of our garden, which is only separated from this site by the Slitrig.

Increased traffic on such a small road would cause disproportional amount of disruption to road users. In doing this there is increased risk of accidents involving general traffic and walkers, pets being exercised, horses and wild life (already this year there have been 2 badgers killed).

The site has no suitable turning or parking which would result in people using private access not designed for this use. A likelihood of drivers reversing out onto the road would pose a risk of collision.

The nature of the proposed use, if granted, would serve to generate more related type activities; in the past this has lead to undesirable results. That is, the thin end of the wedge getting fatter and uglier.

The Civic worth would be jeoparised as any monies collected by the council would be negated by rate reduction claims from us residents. But as an important access route into Hawick the yard would undoubtedly have an adverse effect on the tourist trade.

This area is the start of a 4-mile zone where take-away foods and drinks purchased in Hawick having been consumed, result in packing being jettisoned. Increase in traffic would increase the litter.

# Re Application for Second Hand Dealers Licence Crowbyres Yard Hawick TD9 9SN

I wish to object to the granting of a new licence for a scrap yard dealing with vehicle breakages at Crowbyres Yard, Hawick. My objection is that I believe the site continues to be unsuitable for many reasons for this activity, as follows:-

- The previous licence for the activity at this Yard was rescinded, by all accounts because of contamination. This alone would suggest that the site is not suitable for this purpose.
- Moreover, the Yard is immediately adjacent to the River Slitrig. This river burst its banks in January 2016 and properties on both banks were knee deep in flood water. This area of Crowbyres is on a flood plain and to date no flood defences have been put in place. Any future flooding into this Yard would return undesirable effluent of all sorts back into the river.
- This area has now been re- designated as a 30 mph area for traffic and it is now a residential area. I would suggest it is inappropriate to have a breaker's yard with a licence to operate 7 days a week in the midst of houses with all the inevitable noise pollution. It would also have to be lit up in the evening.
- Road safety is a very real issue as customers to the Yard are instructed to park on the road outside which narrows it down. There are huge loggers which have to get past, often in convoy, farm traffic and of course horses, often ridden by children, in addition to normal traffic.
- The B6399 is a scenic road attracting many tourists to this area of the Borders, also bicycle rallies etc. It does not seem fitting that Crowbyres Bridge, which has been listed as a Category C building by Historic Scotland, should have to compete with a breaker's yard for attention.

In summary, I submit that no-one living here was surprised when this scrap yard was forced to close its doors. This area has changed in nature and is within a 30 mph zone with more housing which makes a breaker's yard in its midst totally inappropriate.

#### Application by Graham Redpath for a Second Hand Dealer's Licence

I wish to register my strong opposition to the application by Mr Redpath for a Second Hand Dealer Licence for operating out of Crowbyres Yard, Hawick

The location of the yard is within an area of special scientific interest and was closed down about nine months ago, possibly due to intervention by SEPA. It is completely inappropriate that this ground should be used as a second hand car dealers yard. There is no drainage in the yard and whilst the premises were used as a scrap metal dealer it was frequently possible to see men urinating in the open, well within the view of passing children.

The road is a quiet road leading to the country and will not cope with the additional traffic that will be generated by a scrap metal/second hand car dealer business.

Dear Sirs, I refer to the above license application and ask you not to grant this for the following reasons :

The area is now more residential than before and to allow this type of business would devalue the status of the area and worth of properties. Residents would be less likely to spend as much on maintenance.

The 'working' noise would spoil our enjoyment of our garden, which is only separated from this site by the Slitrig.

Increased traffic on such a small road would cause disproportional amount of disruption to road users. In doing this there is increased risk of accidents involving general traffic and walkers, pets being exercised, horses and wild life (already this year there have been 2 badgers killed).

The site has no suitable turning or parking which would result in people using private access not designed for this use. A likelihood of drivers reversing out onto the road would pose a risk of collision.

The nature of the proposed use, if granted, would serve to generate more related type activities; in the past this has lead to undesirable results. That is, the thin end of the wedge getting fatter and uglier.

The Civic worth would be jeoparised as any monies collected by the council would be negated by rate reduction claims from us residents. But as an important access route into Hawick the yard would undoubtedly have an adverse effect on the tourist trade.

This area is the start of a 4-mile zone where take-away foods and drinks purchased in Hawick having been consumed, result in packing being jettisoned. Increase in traffic would increase the litter.

## Re Application for Second Hand Dealers Licence Crowbyres Yard Hawick TD9 9SN

I wish to object to the granting of a new licence for a scrap yard dealing with vehicle breakages at Crowbyres Yard, Hawick. My objection is that I believe the site continues to be unsuitable for many reasons for this activity, as follows:-

- The previous licence for the activity at this Yard was rescinded, by all accounts because of contamination. This alone would suggest that the site is not suitable for this purpose.
- Moreover, the Yard is immediately adjacent to the River Slitrig. This river burst its banks in January 2016 and properties on both banks were knee deep in flood water. This area of Crowbyres is on a flood plain and to date no flood defences have been put in place. Any future flooding into this Yard would return undesirable effluent of all sorts back into the river.
- This area has now been re- designated as a 30 mph area for traffic and it is now a residential area. I would suggest it is inappropriate to have a breaker's yard with a licence to operate 7 days a week in the midst of houses with all the inevitable noise pollution. It would also have to be lit up in the evening.
- Road safety is a very real issue as customers to the Yard are instructed to park on the road outside which narrows it down. There are huge loggers which have to get past, often in convoy, farm traffic and of course horses, often ridden by children, in addition to normal traffic.
- The B6399 is a scenic road attracting many tourists to this area of the Borders, also bicycle rallies etc. It does not seem fitting that Crowbyres Bridge, which has been listed as a Category C building by Historic Scotland, should have to compete with a breaker's yard for attention.

In summary, I submit that no-one living here was surprised when this scrap yard was forced to close its doors. This area has changed in nature and is within a 30 mph zone with more housing which makes a breaker's yard in its midst totally inappropriate.
