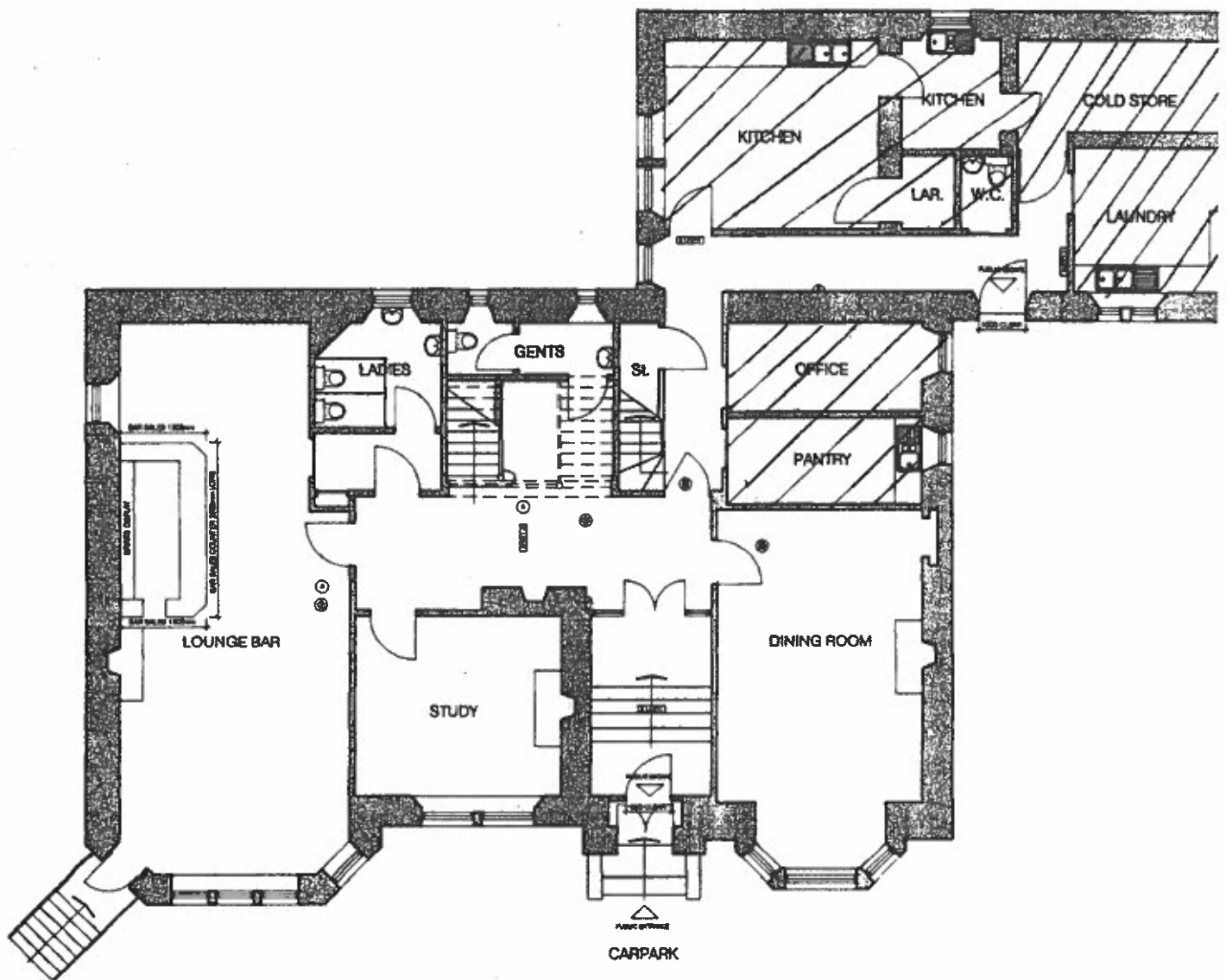

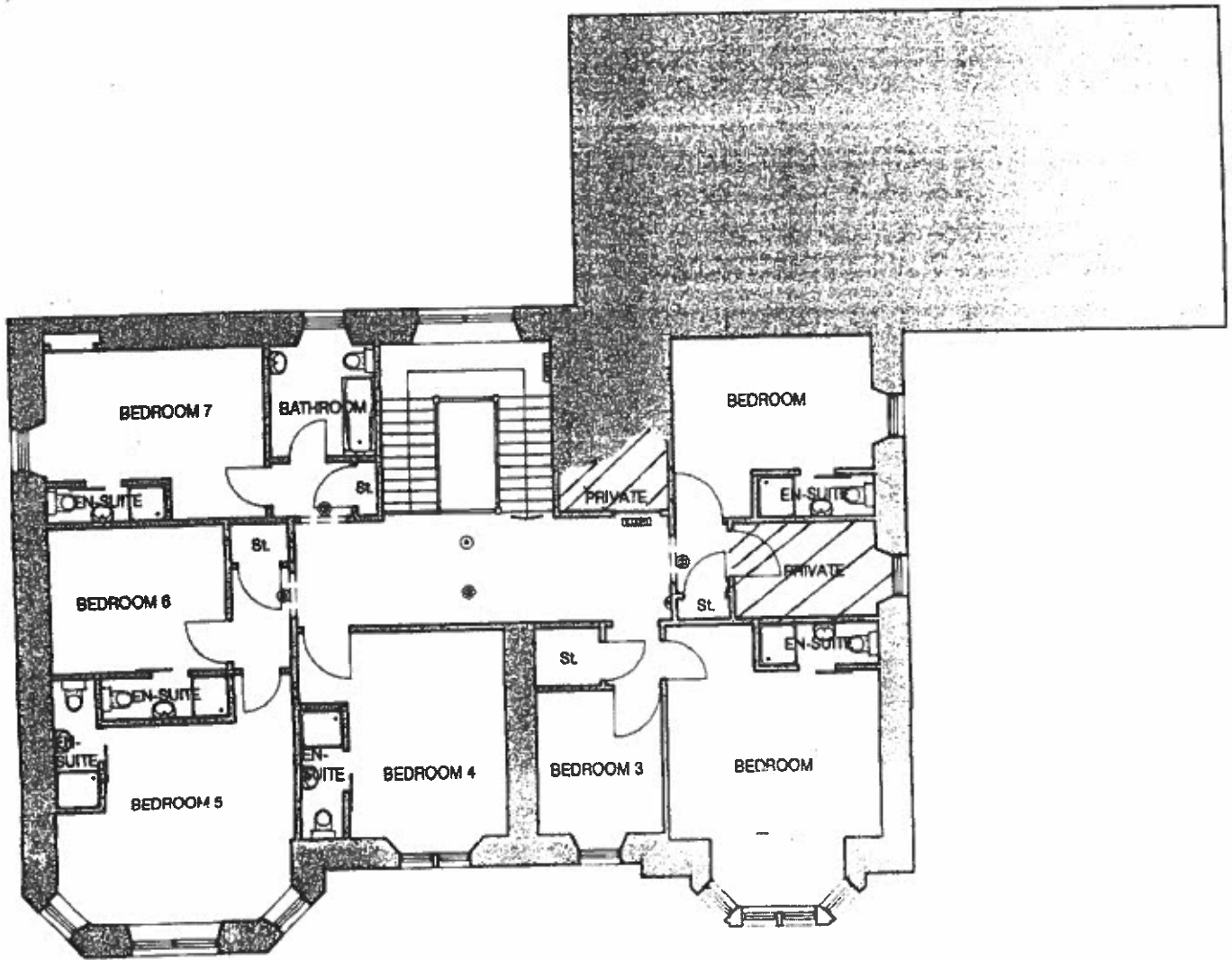
EXISTING GROUND FLOOR PLAN
