#### 3. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005:

**Section 20: Application for Premises Licence.** Considered the following application for Grant/Provisional Grant of Premises Licence.

There had been circulated copies of an application for the grant of a provisional premises license together with the proposed Operating Plan and Layout Plan. Mr Michael Wynne, Licensing Standards and Enforcement Officer advised that the premises were the restored station masters house at Stow Railway Station, which was a detached building within the car park of the station and adjacent to the platform, although there was no access to the railway. The premises were on a single level and comprised of a meeting room, snug bar, and restaurant/café with a small bar area, kitchen, toilets and storage areas with a small outside patio area to the side of the building. The proposal was to sell alcohol on an On and \off sale basis. The application was within policy and no objections had been received. Police Scotland had no comments.

The convener welcomed Grace Murray, applicant, who joined the meeting via Microsoft Teams. Mrs Murray explained that the purpose of restoring the building was to create a facility for Community use and a Centre for the Village to draw people in. The Hub held 9 e-bikes for use by the general public and there were a number of walking routes in the vicinity.

DECISION GRANTED.

#### **QUEENS PLATINUM JUBILEE**

4. There had been circulated copies of a letter from the Licensing Standards and Enforcement Officer requesting the Board consider extending the Licensing hours over the Queens Platinum Jubilee Holiday week-end on 2 – 5 June 2022. It was anticipated that that some licensed premises within the Scottish Borders may apply for extended hours to their current premise licence. In terms of Section 67 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, the Board may determine that it was appropriate to grant a general extension of licensed hours for the Platinum Jubilee Holiday Weekend. This extension would apply from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June 2022 inclusive and would allow an extension of the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol during that period until 1.00am and would apply only to On-Sale and not to Off-Sales of alcohol. There would be no general extensions beyond this (1.00am) although any applications for extended hours outwit the general extension would be considered on a case-by-case basis. There was no need for licensees to apply for the general extension to 1.00am and On-Sales premises could utilise these hours to the extent they considered appropriate. It was noted that whilst most licensed premises within the Scottish Borders had licensing hours until 1.00am on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights, they did not have these hours on a Sunday night (12 midnight) and there would be no requirement for the submission of extended hours applications to the Board.

### **DECISION**

AGREED to grant a general extension of licensed hours for the Platinum Jubilee Holiday Weekend to apply from Thursday, 2 to Sunday 5 June 2022 to allow an extension of the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol during that period until 1.00 a.m.

#### **CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS**

This being the final meeting before the Elections, the Chairman thanked Councillors Brown, Paterson and Turnbull, who were not standing for Election for their contribution to the Licensing Board over the past five years.

Applicant – Jim McDevitt, Personal Licence Holder – SB/LIQ/12688

With reference to the above subject I would make the following objection under the licensing objective 'protecting children from harm'. I have based my objection on the grounds that I consider the event to be a child centred event and the sale of alcohol to be inappropriate. The circumstances are as follows.

The applicant is a trustee of the voluntary group 'A Heart for Duns' and on their behalf has applied for an occasional licence for the hours 1700 hrs till 1915 hrs on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to provide the sale of alcohol at a film showing within the Volunteer Hall, Duns, Berwickshire. The film to be screened is likely to be the Walt Disney animated film 'Encanto' (or a film similar) and is targeted at a child/young person audience. Mr McDevitt anticipates an audience to include 50 children and 10 young persons.

In March 2022, a similar application was received from Mr McDevitt for a film evening on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022. The format of the film evening consisted of a film around 1700 hrs aimed at a young persons and child audience followed by another film around 1900 hrs aimed at a more adult/young persons audience.

Licensing Standards and Enforcement Officer John Scott was consulted on this application and whilst the application form did not state the films being shown he found that the early film was the Walt Disney animated production 'Encanto' with an estimated 50 children within the audience.

Mr Scott considered this a child centred event and as such had concerns over the suitability for the sale of alcohol at this earlier film. He contacted the applicant and gave advice regarding child centred events and the Licensing Boards policy regarding them. The applicant, although unhappy, agreed to amend his application for a licence to commence at 7.15pm, to allow the sale of alcohol at the later film only.

In April 2022, Mr McDevitt applied again for an occasional licence to sell alcohol for a film-evening event at the same location on 15th April 2022. On this occasion I was consulted on the application. The earlier film on this occasion was a cartoon/animated film 'Sonic the Hedgehog 2' with again an estimated 50 children within the audience. I opined this earlier film was a child centered event and informed Mr McDevitt I would object to his application under the licensing objective of 'Protecting

Children and Young Persons from harm'. Mr McDevitt amended his application again to sell alcohol only at the later film.

I have had a number of email exchanges with Mr McDevitt and he rightly states that previous film events, over several years, have been licensed through an occasional licence application for both films. The description of the event on these previous applications have been described as 'film evenings' or 'community film event', without detailing the nature of each film.

Former Licensing Standards and Enforcement Officer Ian Tunnah predominantly consulted upon these previous applications. I have liaised with Mr Tunnah recently and he was of the opinion the film evenings incorporating both films were a 'family event' however he was unaware the content of the films showing. Having stated the aforementioned films 'Encanto' and 'Sonic the Hedgehog 2' he opined he would have considered this to be a 'child centred' event and would have referred the applications to the Licensing Board.

Scottish Borders Licensing Board statement of policy states under the 'protecting children from harm' objective:

"The board accepts many fund raising and community events benefit from granting of an occasional licence but would expect any organisation considering applying, to take into account whether or not it is appropriate to have the sale of alcohol forming a normal part of the event with particular regard to the Protecting Children from harm objective. This should be particularly considered for **child centred events**, related to school, youth or sporting organisations".

The content of the earlier film is in my opinion targeted at a children and young person audience, some of who may attend the event unaccompanied by an adult. I consider the event to be 'child centred' and I do not consider it necessary or appropriate to sell alcohol at this showing and to grant a licence for this particular event would be contrary to the Licensing Boards policy statement and the licensing objective 'protecting children from harm'.

## Application for Occasional Licence: Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022, Volunteer Hall, Duns, Berwickshire, TD11 3AF

I am writing to you in my role as Joint Director of Public Health and chief advisor on public health matters to both NHS Borders and Scottish Borders Council with regards to the above application for grant of Occasional Licence.

I am writing to object to the granting of the above license on the basis that this is contrary to the Licensing Objective of *Protecting Children and Young People From Harm*.

#### **Protecting Children From Harm**

It is noted that this application is proposing to sell and supply alcohol at a film showing within the Volunteer Hall, Duns on 15<sup>th</sup> July between 1700hrs till 1915hrs. The film likely to be screened is the Walt Disney animated film Encanto (or similar) and is targeted at a child audience with an anticipated 50 children and 10 young people attending.

As per the Scottish Borders Licensing Board Statement of Licensing Policy 2018 - 2023, the Licensing Board would expect an organisation considering applying, to take into account whether or not it is appropriate to have the sale of alcohol forming part of an event, particularly child centred events. My observations are that this event is child centred and therefore does not require the sale of alcohol.

Exposure to alcohol and witnessing adult drinking can influence our children's future drinking habits. Our children and young people have the right to grow up in an environment where communities are safe, thriving and are able to grow up safe from alcohol-related harm. We should be creating communities where alcohol is not required as part of a family fun event. I would hope the Licensing



Board use the powers available to improve our community's relationship with alcohol and implement its Licensing Policy in this regard.

I would ask the Licensing Board to consider this evidence prior to any decision being made.

I refer to the above application and in terms of Section 58(1)(a) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I make the following objection.

The applicant seeks to operate an occasional liquor licensed children's cinema on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 with operating hours of 17:00 - 19:15 hours.

This event is child centred and is a breach of the current licensing objectives as mentioned below. It is accepted by Police Scotland that this applicant (and previous applicants) have been granted in the past. However it was not clear that these applications were for cinema showings which were child centred.

In previous applications these events were described as "film evenings" or "community film event" which did not provide details of the target audience. If this had been the case an objection would have been submitted before now.

For these reasons, and in terms of Section 58(1)(a) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, Police Scotland object to the application specifically in relation to the

grounds for refusal at Section 59(6)(c) of the same Act in respect of the Protecting Children from Harm licensing objectives.

Police Scotland are of the opinion that the responsibility for confirming the identity of the applicant, and the validity and current status of any Premises or Personal Licence (including details of any previous or existing suspensions, variations, written warnings or endorsements) quoted on the application form where it was issued in another Board area, rests with the Local Authority and the Licensing Board, not with the Police. When the Police receive such applications we will assume that these checks have been adequately conducted at the point of application and prior to the enquiry being submitted to Police Scotland.
