#### 1.0 **MINUTE**

There had been circulated copies of the Minute of the Meeting held on 21 October 2022.

#### 3.0 ANNUAL FINANCIAL AND FUNCTIONS REPORT

There had been circulated copies of a report by the Clerk to the Licensing Board to seek approval from the Board of the Annual Functions Report and Annual Financial Reports for 2021/22 contained in Appendices 1 and 2 of the report. The Managing Solicitor (Property and Licensing), Mr Kirk advised Members that Licensing Boards were required to provide an Annual Functions Report which must include a statement explaining how the Board has had regard to the licensing objectives and its Policy Statement in the exercise of its functions in terms of Section 9A of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 as well as a summary of decisions made by the Board and information on the number of licenses (including occasional licences) held in the Board's area. Mr Kirk further advised that as a result of the Covid-19 outbreak, Schedule 5 paragraph 4 of the Coronvirus (Scotland) Act 2020 timeframes for the preparation and publishing of annual finance and functions reports had been extended to allow Licensing Boards to prepare and publish their annual reports no later than 31 December 2022 due to the coronavirus pandemic. The Annual Financial Report included a statement explaining how the Board has had regard to the licensing objectives and the Board's Policy Statement in the exercise of its functions under the Act as well the amount of relevant income received by the Board; the amount of relevant expenditure incurred and an explanation on how the amounts in the statement were calculated. Covid-19 had impacted

on the revenue of the Board, which was reflected in the number of Occasional licenses granted being significantly lower than previous years.
