The Committee contact new authors and read many books to then create a shortlist to present to schools. We donate copies to every school along with a pack for teachers to guide them through the process. Children read, review and vote on a favourite book. The winners are invited to an awards ceremony in May to meet the authors. We also use this time to showcase the town of Hawick to our visiting authors, who often stay in local B&B when visiting.
