Nature of Objections/Representations

I write to object to the proposal to extend the opening hours of the shop from 6am until 11pm. This is a very quiet village and it does not require these opening hours. These times would only attract through traffic.

Living above the co-op you are aware of deliveries in the early hours of the morning and extending the opening hours would increase the likelihood of deliveries being even earlier and hearing customers car engines stopping and starting and inevitably doors opening and shutting and would most definitely disturb sleep at those unsociable hours.

McCalls prides itself for the benefit of the community but it also has to consider that residents live above and opposite the shop who can be disturbed by deliveries and customers coming and going at these early and late hours.

Overall, I feel that the proposed increased hours would represent an unacceptable increase on the levels of noise and strongly oppose the proposals.
