Nature of Objections/Representations

The premises were previously operated as a café with soft play area which closed at 6pm every evening. The change to a licensed restaurant would have a significant adverse impact on the residential area in which it is located. Peebles High Street and Northgate already have the highest concentration of licensed premises in the Scottish Borders and therefore there is sufficient choice of establishments for locals and tourists. Whilst the Pana Restaurant has consent to operate as a restaurant through the planning system the late opening hours being applied for through this licence are excessive and unreasonable given its proximity to residential housing. I would ask that the Licensing Committee reject the application or at least limit the hours of the license to ensure that locals are not disturbed by the customers and staff arriving and leaving the premises late in the evening.
