The Income and Expenditure Account and Abstract of Accounts for the year ended 31 March 2017 are in accordance with the Books and Vouchers presented to me.

Treasurer's Report

As is our custom the Accounts are shown on the basis of annual income and expenditure and indicate a surplus for the year to 31 March 2017. Normally Insurance is paid in advance but the cover is being altered and the new invoice, which will show an increase, has not yet been received. Payment for our annual subscription to Archaeology Scotland, which has been reduced to £48 and is now made by direct debit has not been collected but will be in April. The expenditure incurred at Shooting Lee, which was for carbon dating and tree felling, has been largely covered by Grants. Flowers were purchased for one of our members who has been seriously ill. Income from subscriptions reflects the increase in membership fees introduced last year. Visitor numbers were well down from the previous period although the loss of income from this source was more than covered by the sale of books.
