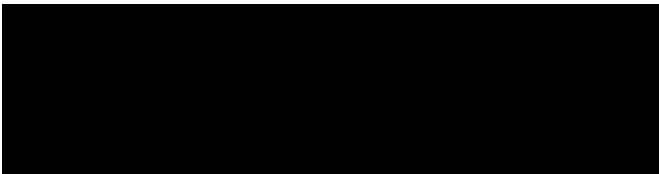

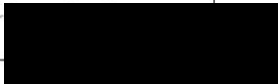
Nature of Objections/Representations

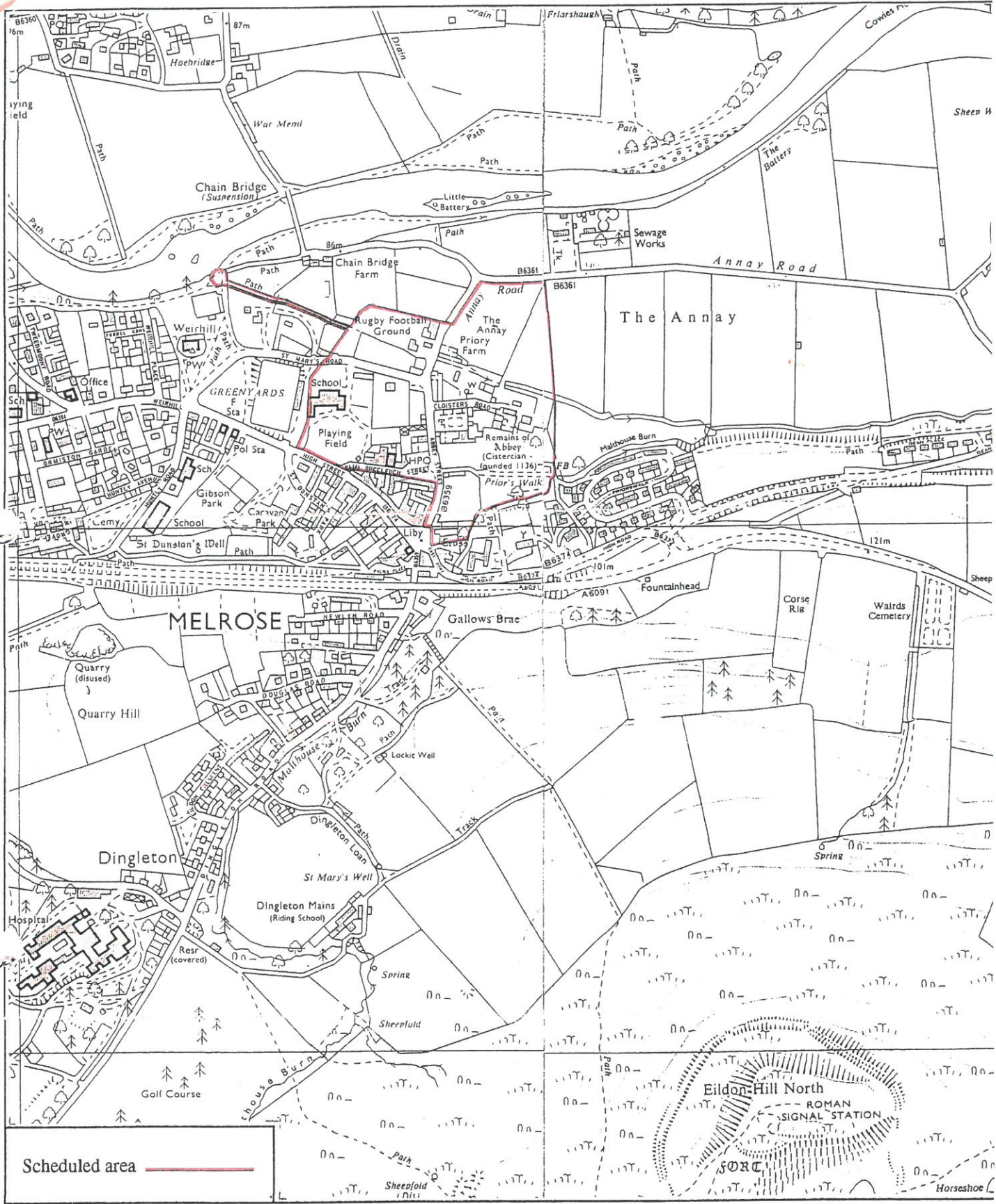
With the exception of the Abbey Mill, the surrounding area is residential. The proposed "Off Sale Hours" from 10.00am to 10.00pm would be totally unacceptable to local residents.

I also note that you propose "activities" as posted to be considered "during and outwith core licensing hours" which realistically gives a carte blanche for "activities" at any time.

May I also bring to your notice that we, i.e. Abbey Mill and surrounding properties are within the Ancient Monuments & Archaeological Areas Act 1979 and are therefore protected within the scheduled monument known as Melrose Abbey & Precinct which requires advising and obtaining permission from Historic Scotland for any intending alteration in use of premises therein. I enclose a copy of the plan.

I am extremely opposed to all the intended proposals indicated in your Notice to Neighbours of application for variation of premises licence at the Abbey Mill, Annay Road, Melrose TD6 9LW.





Scheduled area ———

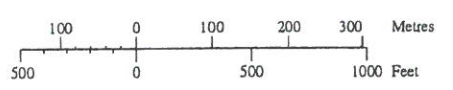
Melrose Abbey and Precinct
