Activities Please supply a brief description of the activities of your organisation and the benefits it brings to the local community: Assistance Requested Please indicate the sum requested and the purpose for which it will be used:	Border Arts Develoment C.I.C. was established to promote visual arts and creativity from, and within, the Scottish Borders. Our flagship event, The Borders Art Fair, takes place annually at Springwood Park, giving local creative practitioners, galleries and collective the opportunity to increase their businesses at an event large enough to attract visitors to the area. In 2018 there were over 5000 visitors spending over £145k with exhibitors. Local businesses, food and drink providers, accommodation providers and, retailers benefit from the additional footfall out with the traditional tourist season. Schools are encouraged to take part in age appropriate competitions and events, and we are running a youth arts outreach programme taking art to some of the more deprived areas in the region. We believe that art should be accessible to all ages and backgrounds, and that our events should bring benefit to the local community. The Royal Scottish Academy have agreed to loan works of art from their collection, to form the basis of an exhibition to take place in Kelso Town House during the duration of the Borders Art Fair. The exhibition will also include printing demonstrations, and will be free to enter. We already run a free shuttle bus service from the Borders Art Fair to Kelso town square, and this satellite exhibition would bring art of the highest quality and, of national importance, into the centre of
	the town, making it accessible to all and drawing art fair visitors into the town centre, as well as other additional visitors to the town. The RSA are loaning their art works and a printing press free of
	charge, but we are applying for funds to help with transport, staffing, venue hire, and insurance of the exhibition at the Town House. The exhibition will benefit from free advertising in the Borders Art Fair brochure (15,000 copies distributed) and free publicity in Borders Art Fair press releases, on the website and, through an already established social media campaign.

The exhibition will benefit from sharing a PR platform with the Borders Art Fair in press releases, and adverts, both on social media and in printed adverts. The exhibition will also be promoted on the Borders Art Fair website.

Awards for All are funding the shuttle bus service from Springwood Park to Kelso town centre.

We have had no previous assistance from the Kelso Common Good Fund, but we wanted to create a satellite event to run in conjunction with the Borders Art Fair, that would encourage our visitors to stay longer in the area and to visit and spend time in the town centre. There are a lot of events at Springwood, but many don't engage the local community, who see little or no benefit from the event visitors. We were established to promote art in and from the Borders, whilst helping to put the Borders on the map as an area of cultural interest, with the aim of increasing cultural tourism to the area. It would be an incredible coup for the town to host an RSA exhibition, and with more pressure being put on the national galleries to exhibit further afield, it would be a good opportunity to start building a relationship with art institutions in the hope of attracting further exhibition opportunities for Kelso.
