I am making application to the Selkirk Common Good Fund on behalf of Selkirk Musical Theatre Company, formerly known as Selkirk Amateur Operatic Society. The name change took place two years ago in an attempt to encourage more young people to join and also to bring the 'image' into current trends within the theatrical community.

As ever the cost of staging a production increases and is now heading towards the £30.000 mark. Within the Border circuit, Selkirk has the smallest pool of potential audience numbers and will be the first to cease performing.

There is a limit to what you can expect a member to pay-currently £60 per season, with discounts for youth members. There are also a number of other costs involved for individuals on a personal level over and above that of the membership fee. There is also a limit as to how many times you can go to the public in terms of fundraising events-currently we go about once every six weeks but are always in competition with many other local organisations.

In light of the adverse weather this year, we have applied stringent budgeting for the current production to ensure that we can continue to stage a production for the townsfolk of Selkirk and beyond in the future.

In line with most other Societies across the Borders we have an active youth policy and currently are doing extremely well in terms of youth and student numbers, as well as continuing to engage with long term members.

In terms of monies, I am looking to apply for and Annual contribution from the fund of £1,500 which, if approved, will be used to offset the costs of hiring halls for rehearsals and staging the annual production.

The Annual production has been a key part of the Selkirk Social calendar for over 100 years and with support from the fund will continue for many more years to come.

On behalf of Selkirk Musical Theatre Company I hope that you will be able to support this application.
