We have attached a detailed proposal which is aimed at rejuvenating a well used though somewhat neglected area of Selkirk town centre. with a focus to increase footfall + visitors to the town.

It is proposed to re-develop the area to create a an inviting area for both local + visiting cyclists by means of a formal cycle park which would include a specialist cycle repair station along with aesthetically appealing cycle racks accommodating 4-8 bicycles along with minimalist seating area + focused signage directing visitors from key receptor points to the new area.

In addition we propose to upgrade the finishes + aesthetic appeal of the existing area by the replacement of uneven + dated paving identifying the area + replacement of the existing coping stone to the adjoining wall which surrounds the well know Chestnut Tree. All of which will safeguard the area as a popular meeting place as well as introduce a new use + focus for the long-term.
