Future Hawick believes that the detailed report prepared last year confirms that the Hawick Welcome is of great economic and community benefit to the town, and the group is greatly appreciative of the funding assistance received from the Common Good last year.

To maintain the project in 2019, applications have been submitted to other funding bodies, but at this stage the outcomes are not known. However, if funding is approved, it is likely that it will not be received until later in the year. Our own fundraising is facing a similar situation, problems in our dealings with Live Borders, resulting in a postponement of our fundraising concert until September 2019. It is therefore extremely likely that funding will be required to cover the wages and administration at the commencement of the 2019 project, and it is for this funding our application is submitted.

As and when other funding comes on stream, it may be that some or all of the Common Good funding will not be required, in which case such amounts could be reimbursed.

Future Hawick received £5,000 financial assistance towards the cost of the Hawick Welcome 2018 from Hawick Common Good Fund.

## INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT to the TRUSTEES of FUTURE HAWICK Scottish Charity Number SC039141

I report on the Accounts of the Charity for the year ended 31 March 2018, which are set out overleaf and below.

#### Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The charity trustees are responsible for the preparation of the Accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investments (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(a) to (c) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the Accounts as required under Section 44(1)(c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

#### Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the Charity and a comparison of the Accounts presented with these records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the Accounts, and seeks explanations from the Trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the Accounts.
