Any time Children or Young Persons are in attendance there is adequate appropriate and responsible adult supervision.

Note: -

For the avoidance of doubt a responsible adult is a person who has the responsibility for the child when attending the premises. The responsible adult should supervise the child at all times while the child is within the licensed area. In the case of sporting clubs it is accepted that this may not always be practical due to participation in sport, in which case the club and its officials would be required to ensure adequate supervision of any child or young person on the premises, in order to ensure there safety and well being.
