I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of:

Amendment to operating plan:

-Amend explanation at question 5(f) as to other activities to include use as a pre and after school club and remove specified day and times for use as a youth club.

-Amend the statement of children and young person's terms of entry and times when they will be permitted on the premises at question 6 (in addition to those currently stated in relation to sporting events and radio broadcasts) as follows:

- **Children and young persons when attending any youth club until 9.00pm;**
- **Children attending any pre or after school club until 6.30pm.**

There is no police objection, however In terms of Section 22(1)(b)(iii) of the same Act, I make the following representation and request that if the variation, or an

amended version is approved, the Board considers the following conditions be imposed on the Premises Licence;

-The bar must be shuttered, and entry door closed and locked, at all times when the premises is being used for youth activities.

-Alcohol will be stored securely within the bar area at all times when the premises is being used for youth activities.
