- Pot A: £23,899.63
- Each CC will receive £2,389.96 with Hawick and Burnfoot CC due to receive two shares = £4,799.93
- The CCs have worked together to create generic documents for the Community Fund which can be adapted as required in their area

Teviot & Liddesdale Community Fund 2021/22

- **Community Fund process:**

- SBC to receive applications to all Pot A funds to check for eligibility, all applications will be passed to Assessment panels
- Assessment panels will make recommendations based on the information supplied within the application form; panels will not ask applicants for further details
- Panel recommendations will be shared with SBC who will contact the applicants with the recommendation
- Recommendations will be circulated with the AP meeting agenda
- The Chair of the Assessment panel will speak to the recommendations at an AP meeting

Teviot & Liddesdale Community Fund 2021/22

- **T&L CCs proposals:**

- The Pot A fund opens on 01 October for CCs who have recruited panel members
- CCs who have not recruited a panel will actively recruit members while their Pot A fund is paused
- A special meeting of the Area Partnership will be organised for December to make a decision on Community Fund applications
- CCs will review how much money is remaining in their Pot A fund after the first round of funding is awarded and make a judgement on whether they think the funds will be spent by the end of the financial year.
- If CCs don't anticipate spending their Pot A pot, they will request to transfer their Pot A fund either to another CC or to Pot B
- The requirement for applicants to contribute 10% of project costs – proposal is to waive this
