

In 2010 Scottish Borders Council agreed to revitalise the Chambers Institution Trust and Appointed 6 Tweeddale Councillors together with the Executive Member for Education and Finance



December 2011 the Trustees appointed 6 Lay Appointees to act as Management Trustees



In 2012, following the Local Government election, the Council decided to appoint only the 6 Tweeddale Members as Trustees

In June 2012 a Lay Appointee was appointed as Chair of the Trustees, though later that summer one of the Lay Appointees resigned and was not replaced



in October 2014, due to difficulties with this model Council requested the Chief Executive to produce a report setting out possible alternative options for the Trust



Following that decision 4 of the Lay Appointees resigned as Trustees, leaving only one in place



In May 2015 Council determined that the Trust would revert to sole Council Control
