THE BIKE STORE IS OVER 5.1m FROM THE CORNER OF THE ROAD AND IS SUFFICIENT DISTANCE AWAY THAT IT DOES NOT OBSTRUCT VISIBILITY (SEE PHOTO 01 & 02). THE MAJORITY OF NEIGHBOURS ARE IN AGREEMENT WITH THIS STATEMENT AND THEIR TESTIMONY CAN BE VIEWED IN THE ORIGINAL PLANNING APPLICATION.

THE VERGE IS APPROX 760mm WIDE AND THE SERVICES ARE LOCATED ALONG THIS GRASSED STRIP AND RUN PARALLEL WITH THE KERB (SEE PHOTO 03 & 04). THERE IS NOT A PROBLEM WITH ACCESS TO THE SERVICES AND THE BIKE STORE DOES NOT ENCROACH THE SERVICE STRIP. THE BIKE STORE HAS BEEN CONSTRUCTED TO RUN IN LINE WITH THE EXISTING FENCE WHICH SURROUNDS THE GARDEN. THIS FENCE HAS BEEN INSITU FOR OVER 8 YEARS AND PERMISSION WAS OBTAINED FROM THE HOUSING ASSOCIATION AT THAT TIME TO ERECT IT (SEE PHOTO 03). IN ALL THIS TIME THERE HAS NEVER BEEN AN ISSUE WITH ACCESS TO SERVICES ALONG THE VERGE.

THERE ARE NUMEROUS LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE TOWN WHERE OBSTRUCTIONS HAVE PREVENTED VISIBILITY TO A MUCH GREATER DEGREE THAT WHAT HAS BEEN ERECTED HERE. THIS IS EVIDENT FROM PHOTOGRAPHIC EVIDENCE (SEE PHOTO 05 & 06).

A SITE VISIT SHOULD BE CARRIED OUT AS IT IS CAN BE SEEN THAT THERE IS NO DANGER OF OBSTRUCTION FROM THIS STRUCTURE.
