Site: Erection of dwellinghouse

After reviewing the new plans for the proposed dwellinghouse, my previous comments and objections to the proposal, as stated in my responses to planning application 21/01257/FUL and 20/01334/PPP, remain valid.

The main street (High street and East End) is at risk of flooding to the East and West of the site and the proposed access/egress point. The indicated flood depths- as per the Earlston Flood Study- indicate that safe access/egress for vehicles, including emergency vehicles, would not be possible during a 1:200 year + climate change event.

I therefore consider the proposal to go against Scottish Planning Policy in relation to residential developments and flood risk.
