Comment Reasons:

- Contrary to Local Plan

Comment: The AHSS Forth & Borders Cases Panel have examined this application and wish to object to the window and door replacement in man-made materials.

'Caddie Cottage' is an attractive one-and-a-half storey house, which remains relatively unaltered externally, and therefore contributes significantly to the variety of historic houses making up its local conservation area.

The proposed uPVC windows and composite door are incompatible with a traditional building and out of character with the house's characteristic style, and represent an erosion of historic interest of the property and wider streetscape.

uPVC also requires ongoing complete replacement, typically every twenty years, and frames are not recyclable as new windows so the environmental footprint increases indefinitely, which conflicts with Local Development Plan policy PMD1 on sustainability.

Our main objection is that they do not enhance or retain the present character of the conservation area, and are therefore contrary to policy EP9 in the Local Development Plan. The windows should be reinstated in timber.
