







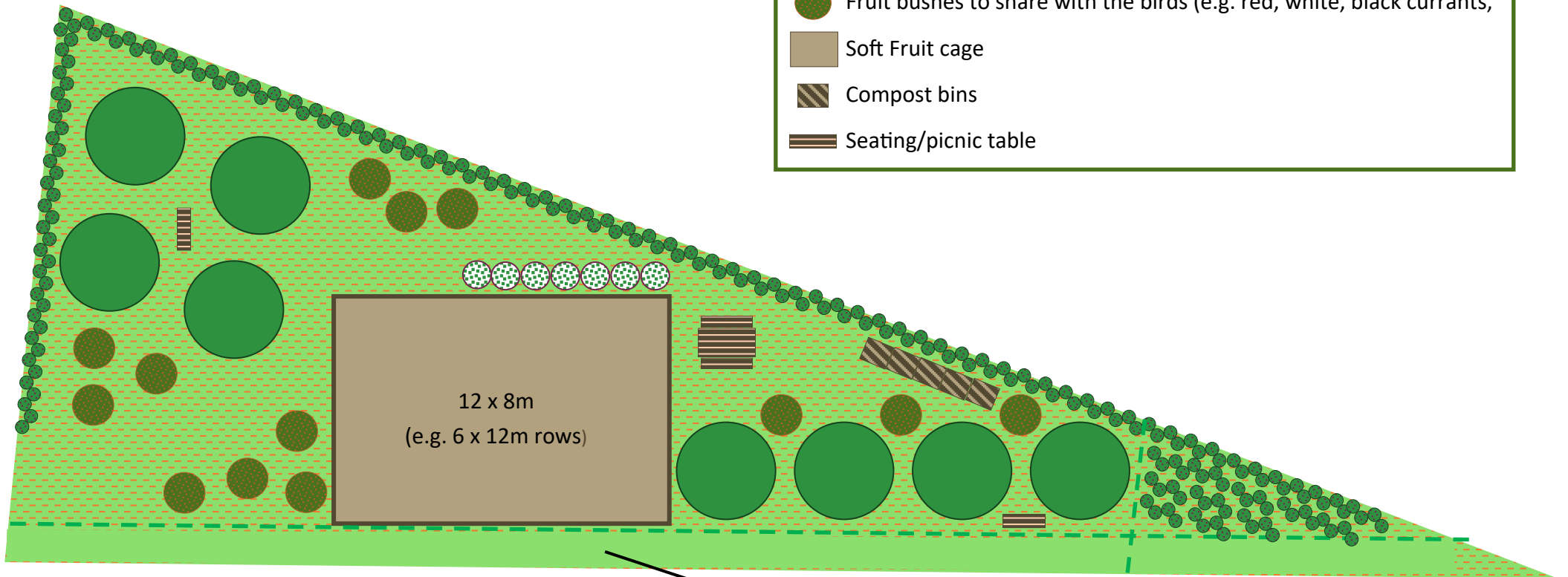


Possible Planting Plan 1

-  Seating/picnic table











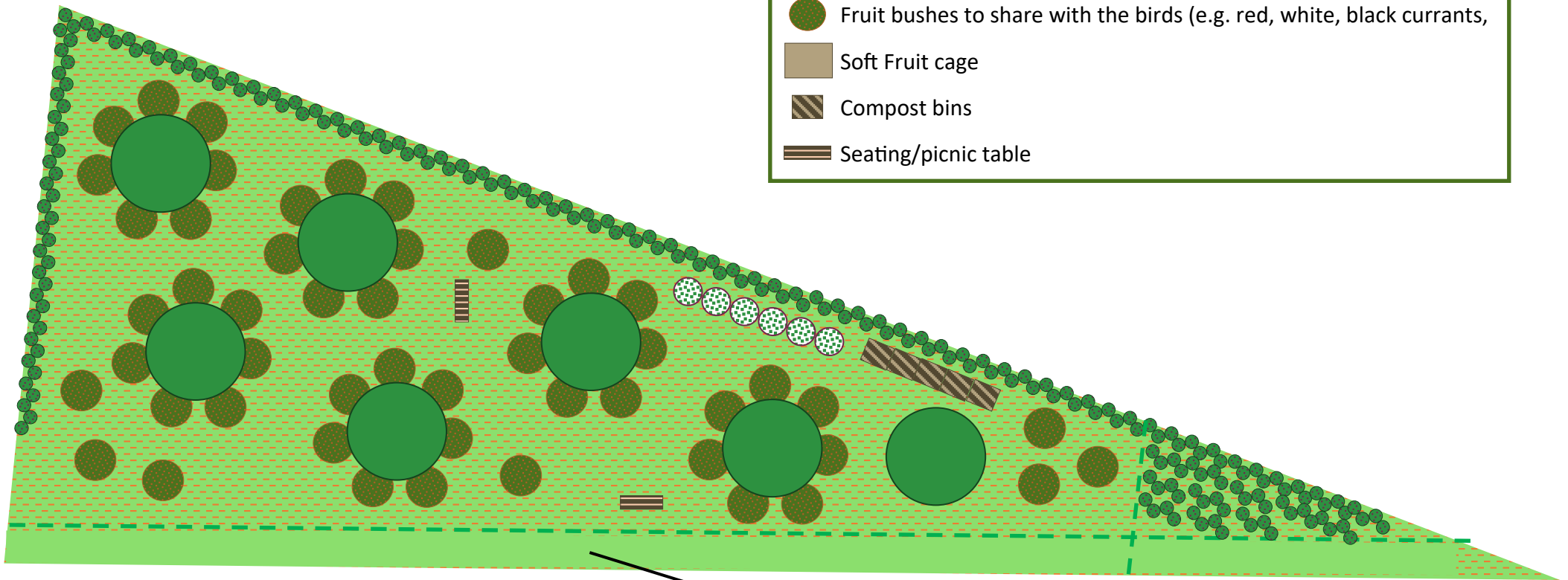
Scale—5cm : 10m
